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6. Accreditation

Accreditation Center is located within the competition venue. Maximum 2 responsible persons from each delegation shall be present at the accreditation center where they will be requested to:

- present to the LOC a valid passport of all Delegation members for proof of identity and control of Nationality
- present to the LOC the gymnasts' valid FIG License for further age control and anti-doping purposes
- check the correct names of their complete Delegation
- settlement of any pending financial obligation
- show proof of valid insurance policy in English
- verify the return flight schedules
- return completed the health-statement forms for all participants – appendix 1
- return completed the relevant form in case of PCR/Rapid tests needed for departure – appendix 2
- return completed the relevant form for HoD's (or his/her representative) contact details onsite – appendix 3
- confirm the accuracy of the Music, uploaded on the LOC digital platform – appendix 4
- confirm their national flag and anthem
- and optionally register for sightseeing – appendix 5

Important note: All NFs that haven't already sent to LOC digital photo of their delegation members via email (ego@otenet.gr) will receive accreditation with no photo.

7. Orientation Meeting

The Orientation Meeting, limited for one person per NF, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative. It will take place inside the Competition Venue (Falirio Olympic Indoor Hall – Olympic Tae Kwon Do Stadium) on Thursday, 16th of March 2023 at 19:00.

8. Ceremonies

8.1 Opening Ceremony

- The Opening Ceremony will take place on Friday, 17th of March 2023, at 18:00 in the Competition Venue.
- Gymnasts will not be participating in the flags' parade.

8.2 Award Ceremonies

- All gymnasts shall be present in the training FOP floor 30' (minutes) before the scheduled Award Ceremony time.
- The gymnasts must wear their national track suit for the Award Ceremonies.
- The national flags of the best 3 individual gymnasts, groups will be presented digitally.

8.3 Closing Ceremony

- The Closing Ceremony will take place on Sunday, 19th of March 2023, at 19:00.
- Gymnasts will not be participating in the flags' parade.

9. Apparatus Control

- The hand apparatus with valid certificates are published on the FIG website and updated regularly.
- Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified hand apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions.
- Random checks will be carried out throughout the event by a representative of FIG. They will take place during each podium training session. Gymnasts will not be allowed to compete with apparatus which does not comply with the norms.

10. Medical Services

- A medical room will be operating in the competition venue starting from Thursday 16th of March 2023, during all training and competition hours.
- An ambulance will be at the venue during training and competition hours.

From the official date of arrival until the official day of departure of the event, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the opportunity to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment or abuse of any type or if they are worried or do not feel comfortable.

12. Covid-19 Guidelines

The Event will be held following all requirements and measures advised by the International Gymnastics Federation and the Hellenic Authorities. Furthermore, detailed Covid-19 Guidelines for the Event, approved by the Health Committee of the General Secretariat of Sports, have been issued and are available in official website of the event.

Instructions to the participants in the FIG/RG/WC ATHENS 2023 with regards to the prevention of COVID-19

→ Arrivals in Greece

- For your information, please take into consideration the requirements for arrivals in Greece at the formal website of the Hellenic Republic Ministry of Tourism <https://travel.gov.gr/#/>

→ According to the current local situation the only requirement for the prevention of COVID-19 in sports regards participants, judges and officials who do not hold a valid COVID-19 certificate (of vaccine or recovery) and should be checked with a Rapid test or a PCR test on a weekly basis.

- A Rapid test or a PCR test in English of a maximum 1 week before the end of the competition should be declared with the registration for the participants, judges and officials who do not hold a valid COVID-19 certificate (of vaccine or recovery), at your responsibility

→ Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires that all participants follow the standard precautions for the prevention of COVID-19. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible. Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FoP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible. Basic preventive measures of COVID-19 are presented below:

→ Masks and face coverings are recommended:

- In closed public spaces
- During the shuttle transport
- For coaches, judges, staff in the venue
- For gymnasts after the training session and during competition when they are not competing

→ General COVID-19 information

The HoD of each delegation is responsible for daily monitoring the condition of each member of the delegation and the possible appearance of flu-like symptoms – colds, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, mild cough, fever. The sick members should be isolated in a separate room and the LOC medical team should be informed immediately.

The athletes, coaches, judges and officials are recommended to keep the following measures:

- Respect the hygiene measures and conditions in the venue
- Keep safe distances of 1,5 m and avoid shaking hands or hugs
- Sneezing or coughing in the elbow, not in the palm. If a tissue is used, it should be thrown away immediately
- Wash their hands with soap and water as much as possible
- Disinfect regularly the contact surfaces and the apparatus and equipment
- The toilets, dressing rooms, trash bins, common parts, apparatus, premises and all equipment should be disinfected as regularly as possible
- Persons with flu-like symptoms are not allowed in the venue
- Disinfect their hands and shoe soles upon entering the venue
- Provide their own protective masks or face coverings
- The athletes enter the floor areas only in half shoes, no sneakers or other shoes
- It is not allowed for coaches and other supported personnel to step on the floors with shoes or sneakers (in case it is needed they must wear medical overshoes)

→ Further specific guidelines may be communicated and implemented separately depending on the current local situation.

→ In case of a mandatory PCR test or Rapid test for the return in your countries, please contact the LOC at least two days before your departure. The tests can be held in the premises and the cost has to be paid by the national federation.

→ On behalf of LOC we would like to let you know that we cannot guarantee that there will be no COVID-19 cases during our competition.

→ In the case of confirmed COVID-19 case, the person is isolated and then sent for additional examinations and diagnosis in the medical center, proposed by the health authorities. The LOC is not responsible for costs resulting from the examinations. The costs of the additional stay has to be paid by the national federation.

In case of confirmed COVID-19, laboratory examinations of all contact persons should take place, with accordance to the health authorities. The LOC is not responsible for costs, resulting from the examinations. The costs of the additional stay has to be paid by the national federation.

In such cases, the Greek health authorities are contacted and if they decide that the whole team should be quarantined, then the respective team should immediately cease its participation in the competition and follows the relevant recommendations.

12. Judges' Panel

According to the valid FIG/TR, the composition of the judges' panel is as follows:

- D Panel
 - Subgroup 1: 2 judges DB1, DB2 (Body Difficulty)
 - Subgroup 2: 2 judges DA1, DA2 (Apparatus Difficulty)
- A panel
 - 4 judges A1, A2, A3, A4 (Artistic Faults)
- E panel
 - 4 judges E1, E2, E3, E4 (Technical Faults)

There will be 1 Judges' Panels.

13. Scoring & Distribution of Results

Results will be operated electronically. The announcement of the results for each gymnast will be appear on the score boards in the Field of Play. The results reports will be available online, on the web.

14. Kiss & Cry area (zone 1)

All gymnasts are kindly requested to wait for their scores at the Kiss & Cry area accompanied by one (1) coach max. for the individuals and two (2) coaches max. for the groups, especially during Finals on Sunday 19th, March 2023.

15. Inquiries

Inquiries for the Difficulty score are allowed Aa per Art. 8.5 of the TR, provided that they are made verbally immediately after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the score of the following gymnast or group is shown.

For the last gymnast or group of a rotation, this limit is one (1) minute after the score is shown on the scoreboard.

Only the accredited coaches in the competition area are entitled to submit an inquiry.

Since in Rhythmic Gymnastics the D-score is divided into two sub-groups - Difficulty Body (DB) and Difficulty Apparatus (DA), each sub-groups is considered as a distinct score and must be challenged separately (either DB and DA or only DB or DA). Thus, if DB and DA of the same routine are challenged, the coach has to submit two inquiries with the respective forms. DB will be considered as first inquiry, DA as second inquiry.
