JUDGES	All participating judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG). The participating Member Federations must provide minimum one qualified judge as mentioned above. Failure to do so will result a fine of 150,00€ - to be paid to the LOC upon arrival.
